



# Handling of packaging at Wehberg Safety GmbH

## 1 General

Wehberg Safety GmbH fulfills its obligation to comply with the relevant environmental regulations and always strives for improvements with regard to environmental protection. For many years we have been monitoring our environmental impact and continuously strive to reduce it, e.g. in the areas of energy consumption, waste generation and the use of materials in production and downstream processes.

## 2 Packaging

### 2.1 Compliance with obligations

With reference to the European Packaging Directive (Directive 94/62/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 December 1994 on packaging and packaging waste) and the applicable German Packaging Act of 2017 (Act on the marketing, return and high-quality recycling of packaging (Packaging Act - VerpackG)), updated in 2021, we hereby inform you that our customers are entitled to return packaging or, optionally, to conclude a special agreement in this regard. We thus comply with the requirements of § 15 (1) VerpackG. Furthermore, we confirm that Wehberg Safety GmbH also fulfills its documentation obligation according to § 15 (3) VerpackG.

### 2.2 Explanations

Within the framework of our extended environmental and product responsibility, the above-mentioned measures support our efforts to reduce waste and to use material cycles in accordance with our environmental policy.

In addition, we apply the priorities of the waste hierarchy whenever economically feasible. This includes the use of reusable systems (e.g. EU pallets and mesh boxes) and minimizing the consumption of packaging material (e.g. through reuse). In the context of the procurement of packaging material, we give preference to recycled material and pay attention to pollutant restrictions as well as good recyclability.
