

## Information letter REACH and RoHS

REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006

Wehberg Safety GmbH has intensively dealt with the obligations arising from the REACH regulation and has implemented appropriate measures to ensure conformity.

Substances of very high concern (SVHC list)

According to article 33 of the REACH regulation, we have information obligations for articles if a substance of very high concern (SVHC) is contained in a concentration > 0.1 % in one of the components. The list of these substances is published by the European Chemicals Agency and can be found here:

If our products contain a SVHC substance in a concentration > 0.1%, this is indicated in all order documents. In addition, the affected products are listed in the SCIP database.

RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU incl. Directive 2015/863

According to Annex II of the RoHS Directive, the following substances must not be present in electrical appliances and their components as such or above the limit values in homogeneous materials:

- Lead (0.1%)
- Mercury (0.1%)
- Cadmium (0.01%)
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1%)
- Di(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1%)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

We confirm the conformity of our products with the listed substance restrictions according to the RoHS Directive Annex II.

For individual products, the exemptions listed below apply in accordance with Annex III of the directive:

- 6a.I: Lead as an alloying element in steel for machining purposes with a mass content of not more than 0.35 % lead
- 6c: Copper alloy containing up to 4 % lead by mass
